Directions

Situated on the A153, 10 miles north of Horncastle and 5 miles south of Louth. If you are approaching from the south, the A153 can be accessed from the A1. Coming from the north or west, use the A1, M1 or M62, then take the M180 to Brigg, then the A1084 to Caistor.

Paddock

The MZs pitch in two areas close to each other depending on; the time they arrive, how much space they need and how near they want to be to tarmac.

Area 1 is at the top of the main paddock (the blue area marked in the grey section on the map below).

The 'top' of the paddock is the first section you'll see on your right hand side as you enter the circuit and head down hill. There's a wire fence at the top of the paddock separating it from a field. MZs aim to pitch near this fence. Space can sometimes be limited but you have the benefit of being right next to a roadway.

Area 2 is in the field on the other side of the paddock fence (the blue area marked in the white section on the map below).

There is normally plenty of space. In wet weather it helps to try to stay near to the main roadway.

You don't have to pitch near other MZedders but you'll be less likely to miss Circuit Announcements. This is particularly important at Cadwell, especially if you pitch on the grass, when you won't be near to a tannoy speaker. There will also be someone close by to show you the ropes and answer any questions.

Electricity & Water

There is no electric hook up at Cadwell – anywhere. You will need to have a generator for power.

There is a toilet block on the left hand side as you head down towards the Club House. The water taps are located outside of this on the left.

Ablutions

There are two toilet blocks and one shower block in or near the Paddock. There are also toilets inside the Club House when it's open. (see map below)

Food & Drink

The Club House serves hot food and sandwiches. It's open all 3 days until late. There are also normally one or two burger vans.

MZedders mix and match between bringing their own food and drink and splashing out at the Club House.

Camping

There is plenty of space to camp in the field mentioned in Area 2 above.

Other Accommodation

It's advisable to try to stay on the circuit due to the early starts – plus it's more fun. If you do need to stay elsewhere the Cadwell Park official circuit website has a list of nearby B&B's etc. Sharing an awning or leaving a van at the circuit can help to reserve a spot near other MZedders. Speak to other riders on the Forum for advice.

Technical Inspection (Scrutineering)

Takes place at the bottom of the Paddock, on the right hand side of the main roadway. Normally open from late Friday afternoon, listen out for Circuit Announcements.

Signing On

Takes place at the Paddock Office which is next to the Technical Inspection area.

Noise Testing

Takes place in the Technical Inspection area.

Collection Area

Entry into the Collection Area is from the main paddock, by the Grandstand toilet. There is no entry from the main roadway. If in doubt, follow another.

Paddock Services

Some motorbike products and services are available to buy in the paddock, including spare tyres and tyre fitting. They can only carry a limited stock of items so it's always best to carry some spares and don't be afraid to ask other MZedders. Nearby Fuel

The nearest Petrol Station is Scamblesby Garage, 1.5 miles away. Turn left out of the main entrance. It's rumoured to only accept cash and may be pricey. Otherwise, your best bet is to head towards Louth. e.g Esso Garage - 65, Newmarket, Louth, LN11 9EG

The nearest BP garage is approx. 18 miles away on the A158 on the way to Lincoln (LN2 4RA)
The nearest Shell garage is approx. 12 miles away on the A158 on the way to Horncastle (LN9 6NH).

Nearby Shops & Takeaways

The garages above will sell some basic items.

The nearest supermarket is in the centre of Louth: Morrisons - 150, Eastgate, Louth, LN11 9AB

There are several takeaways in the centre of Louth, watch out for the one way system.

Mobile Phone Reception

Is very hit and miss.
